SOMETHING MORE – “Your faith has saved you, go in peace.” Immediately after this scene the evangelist states that Jesus journeyed from place to place, “preaching and proclaiming the good news of the kingdom of God.” That was the good news that the woman had already encountered.

And Luke adds, “Accompanying him were the Twelve and some women,” a few of whom he lists. We wonder: Was this woman from the scene in the Pharisee’s house now among those who accompanied Jesus? We don’t know. But Luke makes sure that we do know that there were women among those who went with him on his mission. Over time, has the role of the women diminished? Why would this happen?

This Sunday we can reaffirm what we find in the Gospels. We can accept that Jesus did not put distance between himself and women who loved him, who ministered to him and who ministered with him and the Twelve.

11th Sunday in Ordinary Time – *Focus: Our God is merciful and loving.*

Today’s Gospel offers us some important reminders about forgiveness. We are to forgive others as God has forgiven us. God’s mercy is boundless and he will forgive us for any sin if we place our trust in him, love him and humbly ask for forgiveness. Upon being forgiven, we are to generously love and forgive others.

And Still More – Judas Iscariot betrayed Jesus for 30 pieces of silver. Historians have calculated that in today’s money a silver coin would be worth about \$12. So Judas collected about \$360.

In today’s Gospel from Luke, Jesus is having dinner at the home of Simon the Pharisee when a penitent woman enters the house carrying a large alabaster jar filled with expensive perfume. She uses the entire jar to anoint Jesus. In the same story in Mark’s Gospel, someone complains that the woman’s action is an extravagant waste, because perfume could have been sold for 300 day’s wages and the money given to the poor.

Jesus defended the great love she showed by washing his feet with her tears and anointing him with the perfume. He said, “Little is forgiven to the one whose love is small.”
