

## **HOLY FAMILY PARISH “FAITH IN COLLEGE” SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

Holy Family Parish recognizes the importance of young adults in the Church and the need for young adults to continue their commitment to their faith while attending college. For that reason, the Parish will consider granting scholarships up to \$500 per student based on involvement in Church life either on campus or in the local parish while attending college. Being an active member of the Church while in college not only benefits those being served by the students currently, but also prepares the student to be an active member in the Church after graduation. It is not necessary for the student to attend a Catholic college or university to be awarded this scholarship. Scholarship determination will be made by a committee consisting of the pastor, director of religious education, and the chairpersons of the parish pastoral council and board of education. Applicants must meet the following requirements:

1. Current full-time student (12 or more semester hours) at an accredited college or university or planning to be such in the fall after high school graduation.
2. Registered member of the Holy Family Parish at the time of high school graduation.
3. Completed application prior to May 30th for consideration.
4. Copy of the transcript of grades through the spring semester with the address and required student identification. The transcript may be an unofficial printout (no certification requiring fees necessary). The scholarship will be sent directly to the college or university once Holy Family Parish receives notice that the scholarship winner is enrolled as a student at the end of the fall semester (typically confirmed through a statement of grades from the first semester).
